

RESOLUTION NO. 69 -2012, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL 100% GRANT FUNDING FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES (OCFS) TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES FOR THE CHILD CARE COUNCIL OF SUFFOLK, INC. FOR THE DAY CARE REGISTRATION AND INSPECTION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Children and Family Services has awarded Suffolk County Department of Social Services 100% grant funds in the amount of \$1,033,079, of which \$93,866 is an increase to the Child Care Registration and Inspection Services Program; and

WHEREAS, the 2012 Adopted Budget includes \$939,193 for a contract with the Child Care Council of Suffolk, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, this increased amount is designated for the Child Care Council of Suffolk, Inc., to continue to provide day care registration and inspection services to the child care providers in Suffolk County and oversee a program that provides child care services to over 5,500 children; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Department of Social Services to continue to contract these activities to the Child Care Council of Suffolk, Inc. and this funding will increase their program budget in the amount of \$93,886 from \$939,193 to \$1,033,079; and

WHEREAS, this program is 100% funded and it is in the best interest of Suffolk County to accept these funds; now, therefore be it


