RESOLUTION NO. 238 -2012, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FEDERAL FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000 FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, UNITED STATES IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT (ICE), FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE ICE EL DORADO TASK FORCE WITH 81.53% SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security, United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement, has made available an initial amount of \$30,000 in Federal Funding to Suffolk County for participation of the Suffolk County Police Department in the ICE El Dorado Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the project period is October 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012; and

WHEREAS, said funds have not been included in the 2012 Suffolk County Operating Budget; now, therefore be it


