

RESOLUTION NO. 524-2012, AUTHORIZING THE SALE, PURSUANT TO LOCAL LAW NO. 16-1976, OF REAL PROPERTY ACQUIRED UNDER SECTION 46 OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY TAX ACT JOSE A. OSPINA AND ADRIANA M. ROJAS, HIS WIFE (SCTM NO. 0500-055.01-01.00-009.000)

WHEREAS, the COUNTY OF SUFFOLK acquired the following described parcel:

ALL, that certain plot, piece or parcel of land, with any buildings and improvements thereon erected, situate, lying and being in the Town of Islip, County of Suffolk, and State of New York, described on the Tax Map of the Suffolk County Real Property Tax Service Agency as District 0500, Section 055.01, Block 01.00, Lot 009.000, and acquired by tax deed on September 14, 2011, from Angie M. Carpenter, the County Treasurer of Suffolk County, New York, and recorded on September 19, 2011, in Liber 12671, at Page 592, and otherwise known and designated by the Town of Islip, as Building J, Unit 1F, on a certain map entitled "Map of Plymouth Village Condominiums", filed in the Office of the Clerk of Suffolk County on November 24, 1976 as Condominium Map No. 50; and

FURTHER, notwithstanding the above description, it is the intention of this conveyance to give title only to such property as was acquired by the County of Suffolk by Tax Deed on September 14, 2011, from Angie M. Carpenter, the County Treasurer of Suffolk County, New York, and recorded on September 19, 2011 in Liber 12671 at Page 592.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Suffolk County Local Law No. 16-1976, provision has been made for the sale of such real property acquired by the County through tax sale; and

WHEREAS, SELECT PORTFOLIO SERVICING has made application of said above described parcel and SELECT PORTFOLIO SERVICING has paid the application fee and has paid \$12,483.05, as payment of taxes, penalties, interest, recording fees, and any other charges due the County of Suffolk, pursuant to Local Law, by applicant, through November 30, 2012; now, therefore be it


1st **RESOLVED**, this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Lead Agency, hereby finds and determines that adoption of this law is not an action within the meaning of the State Environmental Quality Review Act and the regulations adopted thereto. See 6 N.Y.C.R.R. Section 617.2(b) (2). The Legislature further finds and determines that even if the adoption of the local law is an action within the meaning of SEQRA, the adoption of law is a Type II action constituting a legislative decision in connection with routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priority. See 6 N.Y.C.R.R. Section 617.13(d) (15) and (21). As a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA 6 N.Y.C.R.R. Section 617.5(a)(1); and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that the Director of the Division of Real Property Acquisition and Management, and/or her designee, be and she hereby is authorized to execute and acknowledge a Quitclaim Deed to JOSE A. OSPINA AND ADRIANA M. ROJAS, HIS WIFE, 45

Adams Road, Apt 1F, Central Islip, NY 11722, to transfer the interest of Suffolk County in the above described property and on the above described terms.
