

**RESOLUTION NO. 573 -2012, AUTHORIZING USE OF  
CEDAR BEACH COUNTY PARK BY EVENT POWER FOR ITS  
MIGHTY NORTH FORK TRIATHLON FUNDRAISER**

**WHEREAS**, an unincorporated entity known as "Event Power" hosts the Mighty North Fork Triathlon events which are sanctioned by USA Triathlon, Inc., a nonprofit corporation having its principal place of business in Colorado Springs, CO; and

**WHEREAS**, Event Power would like to use Cedar Beach County Park in Southold for the purpose of hosting their Mighty North Fork Triathlon on Sunday, July 8, 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, a Certificate of Insurance with accompanying declaration page naming Suffolk County as an additional insured has been provided by USA Triathlon, Inc.; now therefore be it


**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), New York Environmental Conservation Law, Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Volume 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR") § 617.5 (C)(15), (20) and (27), in that the resolution concerns minor temporary uses of land having negligible or no permanent impact on the environment, routine, or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities, and adoption of a local legislative decision in connection with the same, and since this is a Type II action, the County Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the use of Cedar Beach County Park by Event Power for the purpose of hosting a fundraiser on Sunday, July 8, 2012, is hereby approved pursuant to Section 215(1) of the NEW YORK STATE COUNTY LAW, subject to the receipt of a Certificate of Insurance with accompanying declaration page by the County of Suffolk from USA Triathlon, Inc. and the payment of the One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) event fee, and the issuance of a permit by the Commissioner of Parks, Recreation and Conservation pursuant to section 378-7B(c) of the Suffolk County Code, and subject to such additional terms and conditions as may be required by the Risk Management and Benefits Division; and be it further

**3<sup>rd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the Commissioner of the Suffolk County Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, pursuant to Section 28-4(A) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER, to take such measures as shall be necessary and appropriate to facilitate the hosting of the fundraiser at Cedar Beach County Park by Event Power.
