

1st **RESOLVED**, that the appointment of Emily E. Hudson as a Clerk Typist (PT) Temporary, for the Suffolk County Treasurer's Office is hereby approved pursuant to §A6-3(E) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, effective May 24, 2012; and be it further
