

RESOLUTION NO. 542 -2012, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY COMPTROLLER AND THE COUNTY TREASURER TO TRANSFER FUNDS TO COVER SALARIES FOR INTERIM POSITIONS AUTHORIZED IN THE ADOPTED 2012 MANDATED BUDGET FROM THE 2012 ADOPTED DISCRETIONARY BUDGET

WHEREAS, the 2012 Adopted Operating Budget abolished numerous positions of employment from County service; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the 9th - 14th Resolved clauses of Resolution No. 842-2011 (Adopting the 2012 Operating Budget [Mandated]) and the 16th - 21st Resolved clauses of Resolution No. 843-2011 (Adopting the 2012 Operating Budget [Discretionary]) interim positions of County employment were created through June 30, 2012 by the County Executive's Budget Office and certified by the Legislative Office of Budget Review; and

WHEREAS, that sufficient funds exist in Discretionary Contingency Account 001-MS-1991 to fund the interim positions; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the 40th Resolved clause of Resolution No. 842-2011, the 49th Resolved clause of Resolution No. 843-2011 and Charter § C4-23(B), transfer from Contingency Account 001-MS-1991 can only be made via a duly adopted resolution; and

WHEREAS, funds should be transferred from Discretionary Contingency Account 001-MS-1991 to object 1100 Permanent Salaries Mandated and object 1100 Permanent Salaries Discretionary, respectively, to fund the salaries associated with the interim positions within affected departmental units; and

WHEREAS, funds can be transferred from object 1100 Permanent Salaries Mandated and object 1100 Permanent Salaries Discretionary, respectively, once the expense is incurred; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer are hereby authorized to transfer funds within the 2011 Operating Budget per the attached schedule "A"; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller be and hereby is authorized to take whatever steps are necessary to properly reflect these expenses in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that the 2011 Operating Budget be and hereby is amended to transfer said funds on Schedule "A"; and be it further

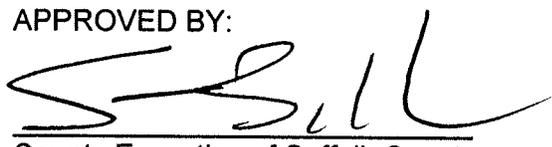
4th RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately; and be it further

5th RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES

AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.

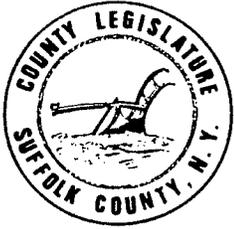
