**RESOLUTION NO. 554 -2012, AMENDING THE 2012
ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND
APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE SUFFOLK COUNTY
WATER AUTHORITY (SCWA) TO SUFFOLK COUNTY
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE PROVISION
OF WELL DRILLING SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County Water Authority (SCWA) Board approved their Resolution 166-05-2010 to perform a groundwater investigation to determine the source of road salt contamination in Fisher Avenue Well No. 4; and

WHEREAS, this groundwater investigation requires that four (4) wells be installed to collect water samples; and

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County Department of Health Services (SCDHS) within their Office of Water Resources has the staff and equipment necessary to install these wells; and

WHEREAS, SCWA has issued Purchase Order number 4500019108 to compensate SCDHS for installation of four wells at a total cost of \$20,000; and

WHEREAS, this additional revenue is not currently included in the 2012 Adopted Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$20,000 from SCWA as follows:


