**RESOLUTION NO. 686 -2012, ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,929.11 FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY SERVICES TO REIMBURSE THE SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT ASSET FORFEITURE-JUSTICE ACCOUNT FOR PREVIOUSLY EXPENDED FUNDS AT 100%**

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services has made \$5,929.11 in Federal pass-through funds from the 2009 State Homeland Security Grant Program available to reimburse Suffolk County for the Alpha-Omega Tabletop Exercise conducted by the Suffolk County Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, this program was designed to increase the capabilities of law enforcement in the detection, prevention, deterrence, and response to terrorist attacks; and

**WHEREAS**, the operational period of the program was from August 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011; and

**WHEREAS**, the Alpha-Omega Tabletop Exercise was conducted on October 4, 2011 and funded using Suffolk County Police Department Asset Forfeiture-Justice funding; and

**WHEREAS**, grant funds will be accepted and appropriated into the 2012 Operating Budget and a journal voucher will be done to offset the forfeiture expense; and

**WHEREAS**, said grant funds have not been included in the 2012 Suffolk County Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said grant funds into the 2012 Operating Budget for the purpose of reimbursing the Suffolk County Police Department Asset Forfeiture - Justice Account in the amount of \$5,929.11;


