

RESOLUTION NO. 683 -2012, MAKING A SEQRA DETERMINATION IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROPOSED SEWER DISTRICT NO. 14 - PARKLAND, SLUDGE THICKENING, TOWN OF ISLIP

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) has reviewed a project designated as the "Proposed Sewer District No. 14 - Parkland, Sludge Thickening, Town of Islip", pursuant to Section 6 of Local Law No. 22-1985 which project involves the installation of a sludge thickening system that will increase the solids concentration of sludge that is transported off site. This increase in solids concentration will have a direct relationship with decreasing the amount of trucks transporting sludge through the community, creating less greenhouse gases and saving labor and equipment costs for the sewer district; and

WHEREAS, at its June 20, 2012 meeting, the CEQ reviewed the information submitted by the Suffolk County Department of Public Works in connection with this project; and

WHEREAS, the CEQ recommended that the above activity be considered a Type II action, pursuant to the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR, Part 617.5(c), (1), (2), (7), (20), (21), (25) and (27) and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code; and

WHEREAS, the CEQ has advised the County Legislature and the County Executive by memo dated June 28, 2012 of said recommendations; and

WHEREAS, Section 450-5(H) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE requires the Presiding Officer to introduce legislation for an appropriate SEQRA determination; and

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County Legislature has reviewed the EAF and the CEQ recommendations; now, therefore, be it

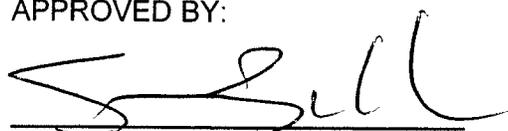
1st RESOLVED, that this Legislature hereby determines that the Proposed Sewer District No. 14 – Parkland, Sludge Thickening, Town of Islip constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR, Part 617.5(c), (1), (2), (7), (20), (21), (25) and (27) and Chapter 450 of the Suffolk County Code, as the project involves a local legislative decision concerning continuing agency administration for the purchase of equipment to maintain, repair or replace existing facilities and the planning and construction of a structure to contain them; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution shall be filed with the Suffolk County Clerk, the initiating unit of said project, and with the CEQ; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that in accordance with Section C1-4(1)(d) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER and Section 450-5(C)(4) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE, the CEQ is hereby directed to prepare and circulate a SEQRA notice of determination of non-significance in accordance with this Resolution.
