RESOLUTION NO. 730 -2012, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT AWARD AMENDMENT FROM THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK FOR AN EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM 68% REIMBURSED BY STATE FUNDS AT SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE

WHEREAS, the 2011-2012 College Operating Budget provides \$90,675 from the State University of New York for an Educational Opportunity Program (EOP) grant to provide counseling and tutoring services on all three of its campus locations, for the period of September 1, 2011 through August 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the grant award has been increased by \$67,926 for the 2012 EOP Summer Program, bringing the total amount of the grant award to \$158,601; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the College Budget in the amount of \$67,926 to provide for the increase in the grant award; and

WHEREAS, matching funds in the amount of \$32,690 are provided for in the College Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Suffolk County Community College accepted the Educational Opportunity Program amendment on June 21, 2012 by Resolution No. 2012.62; and

WHEREAS, the College anticipates spending the increase in the grant award in the amount of \$67,926 in accordance with the terms of said grant before August 31, 2012; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that said 2011-2012 College Budget be amended to reflect the increase in the grant award, from the State University of New York, for an Educational Opportunity Summer Program in the amount of \$67,926, and said amount be accepted and appropriated for the operation of the program as follows:


