

RESOLUTION NO. 731 -2012, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT AWARD FROM THE STATE UNIVERSITY OF NEW YORK FOR A CONVERSATIONS IN THE DISCIPLINES PROGRAM ENTITLED "DIGITAL HUMANITIES AND THE TRANSFORMATION OF SCHOLARSHIP" 53% REIMBURSED BY STATE FUNDS AT SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE

WHEREAS, Suffolk County Community College has received a grant award from the State University of New York, in the amount of \$5,000, for a Conversations in the Disciplines (CID) Program entitled "Digital Humanities and the Transformation of Scholarship" for the period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the program provides funding for a day-long conference to be held in April 2013 on the Michael J. Grant Campus on the topic of how the digital age transforms the ways in which scholarship, research, and creative work in the humanities are conducted; and

WHEREAS, a cash match in the amount of \$2,500 for speaker travel expenses and a waiver of registration fees for up to 100 students for lunch for non-speaker participants, is provided for in the College Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, registration fees are to be collected to cover the remaining cost of lunch for non-speaker participants at a cost of \$20 per person up to a maximum of \$2,000; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Suffolk County Community College accepted the grant on June 21, 2012 by Resolution No. 2012.61; and

WHEREAS, the College anticipates spending the \$5,000, in accordance with the terms of said grant award before June 30, 2013; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that said grant award from the State University of New York, for a Conversations in the Disciplines (CID) Program entitled "Digital Humanities and the Transformation of Scholarship", in the amount of \$5,000, be accepted and appropriated for the operation of the project as follows:


