**RESOLUTION NO. 840 -2012, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH PEDESTRIAN ENHANCEMENT TRAFFIC SIGNAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CP 5406)**

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioner of Public Works has requested funds for construction in connection with Pedestrian Enhancement Traffic Signal Improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, enhancements would include audible pedestrian signals for crosswalks; and

**WHEREAS**, there are sufficient funds within the 2012 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 471-1994 and as amended by Resolution No. 461-2006 has established a priority ranking system as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$50,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (C) (16) of Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), in that the law authorizes installation of traffic control devices on existing streets, roads and highways; since this law is a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of fifty-six (56) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

**3<sup>rd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the County Department of Public Works is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to take such action as may be necessary to complete Pedestrian Enhancement Traffic Signal Improvements, pursuant to Section C8-2 (A) of the Suffolk County Charter; and be it further

**4<sup>th</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of \$50,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:
