

RESOLUTION NO. 118 -2013, TO MODIFY GOLF FEES FOR VETERANS

WHEREAS, Chapter 948 of the Suffolk County Code sets forth the County's parks and recreation fees; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 50-2006 extended Senior Citizens' Park Fee Rates to veterans who are Suffolk County residents, exclusive of golf fees; and

WHEREAS, this Legislature wishes, on a pilot basis, to charge veterans fees for golfing that are equivalent to those paid by seniors, so as to recognize their service to our nation; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that §948-26 of the Suffolk County Code is hereby amended as follows:


