RESOLUTION NO. 990 -2012, AMENDING THE 2012 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO TRANSFER FUNDING FROM THE UNITED WAY OF L.I. TO THE MENTAL HEALTH ASSOCIATION OF SUFFOLK COUNTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTINUING THE PROVISION OF HOUSING MEDIATION SERVICES

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Mental Health (NYS OMH) has approved the reallocation of this funding from the United Way of L.I. to the Mental Health Association of Suffolk County in the 2012 third quarter State Aid letter; and

WHEREAS, the NYS OMH has allocated \$10,625 in 100% State Aid in Adult Clinical Infrastructure funding and \$6,333 in Federal Community Mental Health Services Block Grant Adult funding for the purpose of providing housing mediation assistance for mental health consumers in Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, the contract for these services with the United Way of L.I. ended on April 30, 2012, and the transitioning of these services is crucial to consumers residing in community residences and supported housing units; and

WHEREAS, the Mental Health Association of Suffolk County's program will continue to provide the services formerly provided by the United Way of L.I. to mentally ill adults; and

WHEREAS, the 2012 Adopted Operating Budget includes \$16,958 in funding for the United Way of L.I.; and

WHEREAS, this funding will be transferred to the Mental Health Association of Suffolk County for housing mediation services; now, therefore be it


2nd **RESOLVED**, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute a contract with Mental Health Association of Suffolk County; and be it further
