

**RESOLUTION NO. 1078-2012, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY
COMPTROLLER AND THE COUNTY TREASURER TO
TRANSFER FUNDS FOR TERMINAL VACATION PAY**

WHEREAS, the 2012 Adopted Operating Budget abolished numerous positions of employment from County service; and

WHEREAS, an early retirement incentive plan was offered to County Employees to reduce the number of employee lay-offs; and

WHEREAS, funds were included in Contingency Account 001-MSC-1991-1020 to fund terminal vacation pay; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the 40th Resolved clause of Resolution No. 842-2011, the 49th Resolved clause of Resolution No. 843-2011 and Charter § C4-23(B), transfer from Contingency Account 001-MSC-1991 can only be made via a duly adopted resolution; and

WHEREAS, funds should be transferred from Contingency Account 001-MSC-1991-1020 to object 1020 Terminal Vacation Pay Discretionary; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer are hereby authorized to transfer funds within the 2012 Operating Budget as follows:


2nd RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately; and be it further
