RESOLUTION NO. 1056 -2012, AMENDING THE 2012 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL 100% STATE AID FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES (NYS OASAS) TO THE TOWN OF SMITHTOWN

WHEREAS, Suffolk County Department of Health Services, Division of Community Mental Hygiene, contracts with community-based providers for chemical dependence treatment, prevention, and gambling prevention programs for residents of Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services (NYS OASAS) has allocated \$245,394 in additional State Aid to the Town of Smithtown for operational costs related to the new outpatient clinic and prevention program site; and

WHEREAS, this additional 100% State Aid is not currently included in the 2012 Adopted Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$245,394 in additional State Aid as follows:


2nd RESOLVED, that the contract with the Town of Smithtown be amended to reflect these additional funds; and be it further
