RESOLUTION NO. 1204 -2012, AMENDING THE 2012 CAPITAL BUDGET AND PROGRAM AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH RENOVATIONS AT HISTORIC BLYDENBURGH PARK (CP 7507)

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Parks, Recreation and Conservation has requested funds for planning and construction of renovations at Historic Blydenburgh Park; and

WHEREAS, there are not sufficient funds within the 2012 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of planning and construction of such renovations under Capital Program Number 7507; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006, established the use of a priority ranking system, implemented in the Adopted 2012 Capital Budget as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$500,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5 (C) of Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), and the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of thirty-eight (38), is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

3rd **RESOLVED**, that the 2012 Capital Budget and Program be and they are hereby amended as follows:


