**RESOLUTION NO. 133 -2013, UPDATING RESOLUTION NO. 1045-2008 REQUIRING IDENTIFICATION OF COUNTY PURCHASING PERSONNEL PURSUANT TO NEW YORK GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW SECTION 104-b(2)(f)**

**WHEREAS**, Legislative Resolution No. 1045-2008, "Requiring Identification Of County Purchasing Personnel to the County's Procurement Policies and Procedures," identified the individual or individuals responsible for purchasing and their respective titles as required by section 104-b(2)(f) of the General Municipal Law; and

**WHEREAS**, General Municipal Law Section 104-b(2)(f) also requires such information be updated biennially; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 1045-2008, was last updated by Resolution No. 1241-2010; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that the following County personnel are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to implement the foregoing County procurement policies and procedures:

- a.) Tom Malanga, Principal Contracts Examiner, Department of Public Works;
- b.) Gilbert Anderson, Commissioner, Department of Public Works;
- c.) Anita S. Katz, Commissioner, Board of Elections; and
- d.) Wayne Rogers, Commissioner, Board of Elections;

and be it further

**2nd RESOLVED**, this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) Lead Agency, hereby finds and determines that the adoption of this law is a Type II action pursuant to Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(c) (20) and (27) since it constitutes a local legislative decision in connection with routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment. As a Type II action, the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA.
