

**RESOLUTION NO. 441 -2013, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH THE PURCHASE OF HEAVY DUTY EQUIPMENT AND SPECIALTY VEHICLES FOR COUNTY PARKS (CP 7011)**

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioner of Parks has requested funds for the purchase of Heavy Duty Equipment and Specialty Vehicles for County Parks; and

**WHEREAS**, the equipment to be replaced is either at the end of its useful life or is outdated; and

**WHEREAS**, the need exists to replace certain equipment for the benefit of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, Local Law No. 20-2003 requires that no vehicle shall be purchased or leased unless "explicit approval for the acquisition of such vehicles, via lease or purchase, has been granted via duly enacted Resolution of the Suffolk County Legislature"; and

**WHEREAS**, there are sufficient funds within the 2013 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of purchasing heavy duty equipment under Capital Project 7011; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006 established the use of a priority ranking system, implemented in the Adopted 2013 Capital Budget, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$260,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this action constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR") Section 617.5(25) and (27), the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of thirty-eight (38) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

**3<sup>rd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the purchase of specialty vehicles and heavy duty equipment is hereby approved, pursuant to Section 186-2(B)(6) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE, and in accordance with County Vehicle Standard; and be it further

**4<sup>th</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of the \$260,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:
