**RESOLUTION NO. 1199 -2013, TO APPOINT MEMBER TO THE  
EARLY INTERVENTION TASK FORCE (SALVATORE  
CARAVELLA, M.D.)**

**WHEREAS**, Resolution No. 824-2012 established a task force to examine the County's early intervention program for children with special needs to determine if the program's service delivery could be improved; and

**WHEREAS**, a developmental-behavioral pediatrician must be appointed to the Early Intervention Task Force; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that **Salvatore Caravella, M.D.** is hereby appointed to the Early Intervention Task Force as the developmental-behavioral pediatrician; and be it further

**2nd RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
