

**RESOLUTION NO. 686 -2013, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT AWARD AMENDMENT FROM THE NEW YORK STATE URBAN DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION D/B/A EMPIRE STATE DEVELOPMENT FOR AN ENTREPRENEURIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM CENTER 50% REIMBURSED BY STATE FUNDS AT SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

**WHEREAS**, the 2011-2012 College Operating Budget provides \$73,500 from the New York State Urban Development Corporation D/B/A Empire State Development (ESD) for an Entrepreneurial Assistance Program Center grant to encourage the start of new businesses and the continuous development of existing businesses, for the period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant award has been increased by \$26,093 for the 2012 Entrepreneurial Assistance Program Center, bringing the total amount of the grant award to \$99,593; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to amend the 2012-2013 College Operating Budget in the amount of \$26,093 to provide for the increase in the grant award; and

**WHEREAS**, matching funds, in the amount of \$36,750, are provided for in the 2012-2013 College Operating Budget; and in-kind contribution, in the amount of \$36,750, will be met through space, administrative support, and the associated benefits; and

**WHEREAS**, matching funds in an additional amount of \$13,047 will be provided for in the 2012-2013 College Operating Budget; and in-kind contribution in an additional amount of \$13,046 will be met through space, administrative support and the associated benefits; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of Suffolk County Community College accepted the Entrepreneurial Assistance Program Center amendment on April 18, 2013 by Resolution No. 2013.26; and

**WHEREAS**, the College anticipates spending the increase in the grant award in the amount of \$26,093 in accordance with the terms of said grant before June 30, 2013; now therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that said 2012-2013 College Operating Budget be amended to reflect the increase in the grant award, from the New York State Urban Development Corporation D/B/A Empire State Development (ESD), for an Entrepreneurial Assistance Program Center in the amount of \$26,093, and said amount be accepted and appropriated for the operation of the program as follows:

TITLE OF BILL: Accepting and Appropriating a Grant Award Amendment from the New York State Urban Development Corporation, D/B/A Empire State Development (ESD), for the Entrepreneurial Assistance Program Center, 50% reimbursed by State Funds at Suffolk County Community College

PURPOSE OR GENERAL IDEA OF BILL: To accept and appropriate a grant award amendment, in the amount of \$26,093, for the Entrepreneurial Assistance Program Center during the 2012-2013 fiscal year.

SUMMARY OF SPECIFIC PROVISIONS: This legislation will increase the budget for Suffolk County Community College by accepting and appropriating the grant award amendment from the New York State Urban Development Corporation, D/B/A Empire State Development (ESD), in the amount of \$26,093, for the Entrepreneurial Assistance Program Center.

JUSTIFICATION: This grant award amendment from the New York State Urban Development Corporation, D/B/A Empire State Development (ESD) will provide additional funding for operational costs for the Entrepreneurial Assistance Program Center, 50% reimbursed by State funds for Suffolk County Community College. Matching and in-kind funds are provided for in the College Operating Budget.
