**RESOLUTION NO. 706 -2013, APPROVING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF ANTHONY T. WARRENSKI AS A MEMBER OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY PLUMBING LICENSING BOARD**

**WHEREAS**, Local Law No. 17-1971 authorized the creation of a seven member Plumbing Licensing Board; and

**WHEREAS**, members of the Suffolk County Plumbing Licensing Board are appointed by the County Executive, subject to legislative approval; and

**WHEREAS**, the term of office of Anthony T. Warrenski has expired; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Executive has re-nominated Anthony T. Warrenski to serve as a member of the Plumbing Licensing Board; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the reappointment of Anthony T. Warrenski of East Setauket, New York, as a member of the Suffolk County Plumbing Licensing Board, for a term of office expiring December 31, 2014, is hereby approved, said reappointment having been made pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 563 of the Suffolk County Code; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
