

RESOLUTION NO. 656 -2013, AMENDING THE 2013 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL 100% FEDERAL AND STATE AID FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES TO VARIOUS CHEMICAL DEPENDENCY PROVIDERS FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT AND FURNISHINGS

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services (NYS OASAS) has allocated additional, one-time only, 100% Federal Aid of \$140,723 and 100% State Aid of \$85,500 to various providers for the purchase of equipment and furnishings; and

WHEREAS, NYS OASAS has allocated one-time Federal Aid to the Town of Huntington, Alternatives Counseling Services, YMCA of Long Island, Town of Babylon, West Islip YES, Catholic Charities and HUGS for the purchase of Electronic Health Record (EHR) equipment and furnishings as specified in the award letters; and

WHEREAS, NYS OASAS has also allocated one-time State Aid to the Town of Smithtown, Riverhead CAP and Family Service League for the purchase of EHR equipment and furnishings as specified in the award letters; and

WHEREAS, these additional, one-time only, 100% Federal and State Aid are not included in the 2013 Adopted Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$226,223 in additional Federal and State Aid as follows:
