**RESOLUTION NO. 724 -2013, APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF MICHAEL MURTHA AS A MEMBER OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY HOME IMPROVEMENT CONTRACTING BOARD**

**WHEREAS**, Local Law No. 25-1982 authorized the creation of a seven member Home Improvement Contracting Board; and

**WHEREAS**, members of the Suffolk County Home Improvement Contracting Board are appointed by the County Executive, subject to legislative approval; and

**WHEREAS**, the position has been vacant; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Executive has nominated Michael Murtha to fill this vacancy on the Home Improvement Contracting Board; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that the appointment of Michael Murtha of Bay Shore, New York, as a member of the Suffolk County Home Improvement Board, for a term of office expiring September 30, 2016, is hereby approved, said appointment having been made pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 563 of the Suffolk County Code; and be it further

**2<sup>nd</sup>** **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
