

RESOLUTION NO. 825 -2013, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 894-2011, TO CHANGE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY PET STORE RATING BOARD

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 894-2011 established a voluntary pet store rating program; and

WHEREAS, to ensure that pet stores are rated properly, a Pet Store Rating Board ("Board") was established to review rating applications, conduct site visits and establish each applicant's rating; and

WHEREAS, the Board membership includes a retired veterinarian to be appointed by the Long Island Veterinary Medical Association; and

WHEREAS, no retired veterinarian was ever appointed; and

WHEREAS, the composition of the Board should be amended to allow for a working veterinarian to be appointed to serve; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the 13th RESOLVED clause of Resolution No. 894-2011 is hereby amended as follows:

13th RESOLVED, that the Suffolk County Pet Store Rating Board shall consist of the following five (5) members:

- 4) [a retired veterinarian selected by the Long Island Veterinary Medical Association] a veterinarian practicing in the County of Suffolk, to be appointed by the Presiding Officer of the County Legislature; and

2nd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
