

**RESOLUTION NO. 845 -2013, APPROVING THE DONATION
OF CERTAIN ITEMS TO THE SUFFOLK COUNTY HISTORICAL
SOCIETY**

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County Historical Society seeks to preserve and document the history of Suffolk County; and

WHEREAS, the museum's collection consists of approximately 20,000 objects that illustrate the history of Suffolk County and Long Island; and

WHEREAS, four Depression era paintings and a mural were displayed at the Foley Skilled Nursing Facility before it closed earlier this year; and

WHEREAS, the paintings and the mural, produced through the support of the Works Progress Administration (WPA), depict life at the County's old infirmary and other scenes from life in Suffolk County during this era; and

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County Historical Society has requested that the County donate the paintings and the mural to their care and custody; and

WHEREAS, such a donation will safeguard an important piece of Suffolk County history and culture; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the County of Suffolk hereby approves the donation of four paintings and a mural, as described in this resolution and as represented in the Exhibit "A" attached to this resolution, to the Suffolk County Historical Society, 300 W. Main Street, Riverhead, New York 11901; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
