RESOLUTION NO. 851-2013, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION RENOVATIONS AND ALTERATIONS TO PROBATION BUILDINGS (CP 3063)

WHEREAS, the Acting Director of Probation has requested funds in connection with renovations and alterations to probation buildings; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds within the 2013 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994 and as amended by Resolution No. 461-2006 has established a priority ranking system as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith has authorized the issuance of \$25,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act Environmental Conservation Law Article 8 ("SEQRA"), classified this action as a Type II action pursuant to the provisions of Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR") Section 617.5 (C), (1), (2), as this action concerns the replacement and rehabilitation involving no substantial changes to an existing structure, or reconstruction of a structure or facility in kind; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of fifty-six (56), is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

3rd **RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of the \$25,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and are hereby appropriated as follows:
