RESOLUTION NO. 785 -2013, AMENDING THE 2013 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE 100% ADDITIONAL STATE AID FROM THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF MENTAL HEALTH TO CLUBHOUSE OF SUFFOLK FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTINUING A PILOT PROGRAM IN SUFFOLK COUNTY TO ASSIST VETERANS SUFFERING FROM POST-TRAUMATIC STRESS DISORDER

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Mental Health (NYS OMH) has issued the third quarter State Aid letter for 2013; and

WHEREAS, the NYS OMH has allocated \$185,000 in 100% additional State Aid for the continuation of a pilot program using individual and small group peer-to-peer counseling methods to assist veterans suffering from Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD); and

WHEREAS, the NYS OMH has authorized Suffolk County to contract with Clubhouse of Suffolk to develop the project deliverables for the pilot program; and

WHEREAS, these additional funds are being authorized as a Special Legislative Grant as one-time funding of \$185,000 effective 7/1/2013; and

WHEREAS, these additional 100% State Aid funds are not currently included in the 2013 Adopted Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$185,000 in additional State Aid as follows:
