RESOLUTION NO. 860 -2013, APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH SUFFOLK COUNTY HIGHWAY REHABILITATION PROJECT (CP 5576)

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Public Works has requested funds for construction in connection with Suffolk County Highway Rehabilitation Project; and

WHEREAS, these funds will provide full-depth pavement rehabilitation, asphalt resurfacing, repair/installation of curbing and sidewalk, repairs to drainage structures and traffic safety modifications; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used primarily on CR 92, Oakwood Road, Town of Huntington, and within existing right-of-ways on additional County roads as needed; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds within the 2013 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of said request; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994 and as amended by Resolution No. 461-2006 has established a priority ranking system as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$4,000,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), Environmental Conservation Law Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Section 617.5(C) (1) and (4), of Title 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR"), in that the law authorizes maintenance or repair involving no substantial changes in an existing structure or facility as well as repaving of existing highways not involving the addition of new travel lanes; since this law is a Type II action, the Legislature has not further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of sixty-five (65) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

3rd **RESOLVED**, that the County Department of Public Works is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to take such action as may be necessary to complete Suffolk County Highway Rehabilitation Project, pursuant to Section C8-2 (A) of the Suffolk County Charter; and be it further

4th **RESOLVED**, that the proceeds of \$4,000,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and they are hereby appropriated as follows:
