RESOLUTION NO. 834 -2013, APPROVING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF DORIS WAGNER AS A MEMBER OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH, MENTAL RETARDATION AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES, AND ALCOHOL AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE PLANNING AND ADVISORY BOARD

WHEREAS, Article 41 of New York State Mental Hygiene Law and Section A9-3 of the Administrative Code of Suffolk County call for the appointment of fifteen (15) members to the Suffolk County Community Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities, and Alcohol and Substance Abuse Planning and Advisory Board (Community Services Advisory Board); and

WHEREAS, all terms for previously appointed Community Services Advisory Board members have expired; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive of Suffolk County has nominated Doris Wagner of West Babylon, NY for reappointment to position No. 11 as a member of the Community Services Advisory Board, in which position she has continued to serve as a holdover; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that pursuant to the nomination of the County Executive of Suffolk County of Doris Wagner of West Babylon, NY to position No. 11, as a member of the Suffolk County Community Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities, and Alcohol and Substance Abuse Planning and Advisory Board for a term of office continuing upon the date this resolution is adopted, and continuing further to its expiration on December 31, 2013, the same hereby is approved; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environment Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action and pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20) and/or (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATION (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
