**RESOLUTION NO. 890 -2013, APPROVING THE
REAPPOINTMENT OF PENNY WELLS LA VALLE AS
DIRECTOR OF REAL PROPERTY TAX SERVICE AGENCY
FOR THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK**

1st **RESOLVED**, that the reappointment of Penny Wells LaValle, of Port Jefferson, New York, 11777, as Director of Real Property Tax Service Agency for the County of Suffolk, for a term of office expiring September 30, 2019, be and the same is hereby approved effective immediately upon approval of the Suffolk County Legislature, this reappointment being made by the Suffolk County Executive pursuant to the provisions of Section 1530 of Real Property Tax Law and Section 33-1 of the Suffolk County Charter; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this law constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5 (C) (20) of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management, and information collection. The Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this law.
