RESOLUTION NO. 967 -2013, APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF JOHN O'NEILL AS COMMISSIONER OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, John O'Neill has served as the Chief Deputy Commissioner of the Department of Social Services since April 2012, and as the Acting Commissioner of the Department of Social Services since January 2013; and

WHEREAS, John O'Neill resides in Massapequa Park, Nassau County, New York; and

WHEREAS, John O'Neill meets the specifications for a local Social Services Commissioner, pursuant to Title 18, New York Codes, Rules and Regulations, Part 679; now, therefore, be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the appointment of John O'Neill, residing in Massapequa Park, Nassau County, as Commissioner of Social Services of Suffolk County is hereby approved for a five year term of office which shall expire on November 6, 2018, said appointment having been made by the County Executive pursuant to section 116 of the New York Social Services Law; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
