

RESOLUTION NO. 1086 -2013, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING 100% FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$159,000 FOR THE 2012 ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT (AFG) PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF FIRE, RESCUE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES AND TO EXECUTE GRANT RELATED AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, FEMA has awarded the Suffolk County Department of Fire, Rescue and Emergency Services Federal funds under the 2012 AFG Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the 2012 AFG Grant Program will provide funds to the Department of Fire, Rescue and Emergency Services to enhance its Ready Suffolk Prevention and Preparedness program with an all hazard smart fire safety and emergency training trailer; and

WHEREAS, this grant is for a twelve (12) month period from 07/19/2013 through 07/18/2014 in which the County will receive 100% grant funding in the amount of \$159,000 for the 2012 AFG Program; and

WHEREAS, the 2012 AFG grant includes funding for the purchase of one (1) all hazard smart fire safety and emergency training trailer; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of this vehicle will increase the fleet of the Dept. of FRES by one (1); and

WHEREAS, Chapter 186 of the Suffolk County Code requires that no vehicle shall be purchased or leased unless explicit approval for the acquisition of such vehicle, via lease or purchase has been granted via duly enacted Resolution of the Suffolk County Legislature; and

WHEREAS, said funds have not been included in the 2013 Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept \$159,000 and appropriate said grant funds as follows:

4th **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of the Title 6 of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the New York Environmental Conservation Law as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council of Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
