

**RESOLUTION NO. 1160 -2013, AMENDING THE 2013
CAPITAL BUDGET AND PROGRAM AND APPROPRIATING
FUNDS IN CONNECTION WITH DECOMMISSIONING AND
DEMOLITION OF COUNTY FACILITIES (CP 1665)**

WHEREAS, adopted Resolution No. 32-2013 authorized the acquisition of the Kramer property in the Town of Brookhaven, Village of Mastic Beach, under the new Suffolk County Drinking Water Protection Program (effective December 1, 2007), Open Space component; and

WHEREAS, this property meets criteria required under Section C12-2(A)(1) of the Suffolk County Charter, as freshwater/tidal wetlands and buffer lands for same; and

WHEREAS, this property will be transferred to the County Department of Parks, Recreation, and Conservation, for passive recreational use, once purchased; and

WHEREAS, the on-site structure needs to be properly removed, and asbestos removal will be required; and

WHEREAS, land acquisition funding is not available to pay these essential costs; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are not included in the 2013 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of this necessary project, and pursuant to the Suffolk County Charter, Section C4-13, an offsetting authorization must be provided from another capital project; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$80,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006, established the use of a priority ranking system, implemented in the Adopted 2013 Capital Budget, as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of fifty-five (55) is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994, as revised by Resolution No. 461-2006; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the 2013 Capital Budget and Program be and is hereby amended as follows:
