**RESOLUTION NO. 1122 -2013, APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF A RELATIVE OF A COUNTY LEGISLATOR TO A POSITION IN THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, LICENSING AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS**

**WHEREAS**, §A6-3(B) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE requires Legislative approval for the hiring or promotion of any relative of another County official as defined herein, or who is a relative of a County Police official holding the rank of Captain or above, for a position not being filled pursuant to New York Civil Service Law competitive examinations or for promotional or supervisory positions in the Suffolk County Police Department, then such hiring or promoting shall not be effective unless or until it is approved by a resolution of the Suffolk County Legislature; and

**WHEREAS**, the Suffolk County Department of Labor, Licensing and Consumer Affairs would like to offer a position of employment to Jacqueline Horsley, daughter of County Legislator Wayne Horsley; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that the appointment of Jacqueline Horsley to the position of Intergovernmental Analyst I in the Suffolk County Department of Labor, Licensing and Consumer Affairs is hereby approved pursuant to §A6-3(B) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE; and be it further

**2nd RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
