

RESOLUTION NO. 1123 -2013, TO APPROVE THE LEASE OF TWO (2) NEW FIFTEEN (15) PASSENGER VANS IN THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF LABOR, LICENSING AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County Department of Labor, Licensing and Consumer Affairs desires the acquisition, by leasing, of two (2) full-size, fifteen (15) passenger vans to be used to transport participants in the Suffolk Works Employment Program; and

WHEREAS, such new vehicles would increase the total number of vehicles in the Department's fleet; and

WHEREAS, the cost of such leased vehicles may be allocated to the Suffolk Works Employment Program, in compliance with the approved New York State Cost Allocation Plan for the Suffolk County Department of Labor, Licensing and Consumer Affairs and in accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 48, Part 31, which categorizes vehicle lease costs for Federal grant programs as an "allowable cost" to the extent that the rates are reasonable; and

WHEREAS, the 2014 Adopted Budget includes sufficient funding for the leasing of two additional vehicles by the Suffolk County Department of Labor, Licensing and Consumer Affairs; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 255 of the Suffolk County Code, entitled "Vehicles, County-owned" provides that no vehicle of any nature whatsoever shall be purchased or leased by the County of Suffolk unless explicit approval for the acquisition of such vehicle is granted via duly enacted resolution of the County of Suffolk; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the Suffolk County Department of Labor, Licensing and Consumer Affairs is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement(s) for the acquisition, by lease, of two (2) new, full-size 15-passenger vans, in accordance with the requirements of Suffolk County Code § 255-2(B)(6); and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that such lease agreements shall not be effective before January 1, 2014.
