RESOLUTION NO. 1125 -2013, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION, INC., PARKS POLICE UNIT COVERING TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 30, 2013 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2018

WHEREAS, the County Executive, the Director of Labor Relations, and the Suffolk County Police Benevolent Association, Inc., Parks Police Unit have reached an agreement covering terms and conditions of employment for the period October 30, 2013 through December 31, 2018, subject to the approval, to the extent necessary, by the Suffolk County Legislature; and

WHEREAS, such agreement has been set down in a Memorandum of Agreement, a copy of which has been filed with the Clerk of the Suffolk County Legislature; and

WHEREAS, such agreement has been ratified by the Suffolk County Police Benevolent Association, Inc., Parks Police Unit; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, that the County Executive be and is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with the Suffolk County Police Benevolent Association, Inc., Parks Police Unit in accordance with the Memorandum of Agreement dated October 30, 2013, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Suffolk County Legislature, covering terms and conditions of employment for the period October 30, 2013 through December 31, 2018; and be it further

2nd **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) AND WITHIN THE MEANING OF Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management, and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
