RESOLUTION NO. 1141 -2013, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FEDERAL FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$17,203 FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION, FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE DEA LONG ISLAND TASK FORCE WITH 77.01% SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration, has made \$17,203 in funding available to Suffolk County for participation of the Suffolk County Police Department in the DEA Long Island Task Force; and

WHEREAS, said project is a multi-agency task force designed to combat illegal drug activity through a program of enforcement and investigation; and

WHEREAS, the operational period of the Program is from September 30, 2013 through September 29, 2014; and

WHEREAS, said reimbursement funds have not been included in the 2013 Suffolk County Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said reimbursement funds as follows:
