RESOLUTION NO. 1143 -2013, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FEDERAL FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000 FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, UNITED STATES IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT (ICE), FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE ICE EL DORADO TASK FORCE WITH 77.01% SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security, United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement, has made available an initial amount of \$30,000 in Federal funding to Suffolk County for participation of the Suffolk County Police Department in the ICE El Dorado Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the project period is October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, said funds have not been included in the 2013 Suffolk County Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said reimbursement funds as follows:
