RESOLUTION NO. 1144 -2013, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING GRANT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$225,225 FROM THE STATE OF NEW YORK GOVERNOR'S TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE PASSED THROUGH THE STOP-DWI FOUNDATION FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY STOP-DWI PROGRAM TO FUND DWI ENFORCEMENT RELATED HIGH VISIBILITY ROAD CHECK PATROLS WITH 82.77% SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the State of New York Governor's Traffic Safety Committee has awarded \$225,225 in Federal Highway Safety pass-through funds to the STOP-DWI Foundation for the Suffolk County STOP-DWI Program to fund high visibility road check patrols by the Suffolk County Police Department, Suffolk County Sheriff's Office, the Suffolk County Parks Department, and other local associated law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, said high visibility road check patrols will target enforcement of DWI laws to increase highway safety, and will include Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) call-outs; and

WHEREAS, the operational period of the program will be from October 1, 2013, through September 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, \$66,528 of said grant funding will be used to fund DWI enforcement efforts by Associated Law Enforcement Agencies (ALEA) located in Suffolk County Towns and Villages; and

WHEREAS, said ALEA will contract directly with the Suffolk County STOP-DWI Program for reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, \$158,697 of said grant funding will fund DWI enforcement efforts by the Suffolk County Police Department, Suffolk County Sheriff's Office, and Suffolk County Parks Department; and

WHEREAS, said grant funds totaling \$225,225 have not been included in the 2013 Suffolk County Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said grant funds as follows:
