

RESOLUTION NO. 1089 -2013, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,365 FROM THE NEW YORK STATE GOVERNOR'S TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE GRANT (GTSC FFY2014) HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT TO FUND THE SHERIFF'S SMART START PROGRAM WITH 100% SUPPORT FOR SHERIFF'S TRAFFIC SAFETY INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, the New York State Governor's Traffic Safety Committee has made \$9,365 in funds available to Suffolk County for the (GTSC FFY14) Highway Safety Grant to be administered by the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, this program provides public information and education to young and new drivers, designed to save lives and reduce motor vehicle accidents; and

WHEREAS, the operational period of the program is from October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, said grant funds have not been included in the 2014 Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Executive and Sheriff are authorized to execute any Agreement with the State of New York, as necessary, to secure said grant funds; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said unbudgeted grant funds in the amount of \$9,365 as follows:
