**RESOLUTION NO. 120 -2014, TO MAKE PERMANENT
DISCOUNTED GOLF FEES FOR VETERANS AND ACTIVE
MILITARY PERSONNEL**

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 118-2013 established a pilot program to charge military veterans golfing fees equivalent to those paid by senior citizens; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 538-2013 amended the pilot program to offer active duty members of the Armed Forces the discounted golf fees; and

WHEREAS, the discounted golf fees for veterans and active duty military personnel will expire on March 11, 2014, unless extended by another resolution of the County of Suffolk; and

WHEREAS, this Legislature wishes to make permanent a policy that charges veterans and active duty members of the Armed Forces golfing fees that are equivalent to those paid by senior citizens; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the amendments to the County's golf fee schedule effectuated by Resolution Nos. 118-2013 and 538-2013, are hereby extended and made permanent subject to future revisions made by subsequent resolution(s) of the County of Suffolk; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
