

RESOLUTION NO. 61 -2014, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$23,670 FROM THE NEW YORK STATE GOVERNOR'S TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE (GTSC FFY2014) POLICE TRAFFIC SAFETY (PTS) PROGRAM WITH 100% SUPPORT FOR THE SHERIFF'S TRAFFIC SAFETY INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, the New York State Governor's Traffic Safety Committee has made \$23,670 in funds available to Suffolk County for the (GTSC FFY2014) Police Traffic Safety (PTS) Program to be administered by the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, this program provides high visibility enforcement to increase seat belt usage and reduce aggressive, speeding, distracted and other dangerous driving behaviors in an effort to reduce serious injury and death from traffic crashes; and

WHEREAS, the operational period of the program is from October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, said grant funds have not been included in the 2014 Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Executive and Sheriff are authorized to execute any Agreement with the State of New York, as necessary, to secure said grant funds; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said unbudgeted grant funds in the amount of \$23,670.00 as follows:
