RESOLUTION NO. 62 -2014, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,148 IN FEDERAL PASS-THROUGH FUNDS FROM THE NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE EXPLOSIVE DETECTION CANINE TEAM FY2013 GRANT PROGRAM WITH 100% SUPPORT

WHEREAS, The New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services has awarded \$16,148 in Federal pass-through funds from the Explosive Detection Canine Team FY2013 Grant Program to the Suffolk County Police Department; and

WHEREAS, said project is designed to enhance the Suffolk County Police Department Canine Section's capabilities in the areas of prevention, deterrence, and response to Improvised Explosive Device (IED) incidents through the purchase and installation of an explosive storage magazine; and

WHEREAS, the operational period of the Project will be from November 12, 2013 through August 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, said grant funds totaling \$16,148 have not been included in the 2014 Suffolk County Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and County Treasurer be and they hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate said grant funds as follows:
