RESOLUTION NO. 57 -2014, AMENDING THE 2014 ADOPTED OPERATING BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE 100% FEDERAL AID PASSED THROUGH THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF MENTAL HEALTH FOR FAMILY SERVICE LEAGUE FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXPANDING COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES AND RESPITE SERVICES FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Mental Health (NYS OMH) has issued the first quarter State Aid letter for 2014; and

WHEREAS, the NYS OMH has allocated \$61,932 in the Federal Community Mental Health Services Block Grant - Children and Youth Funding; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this funding is to expand community mental health family support services and respite services for Suffolk County children and youth ages 5-17 who are diagnosed with serious emotional disturbances; and

WHEREAS, these funds are not currently included in the 2014 Suffolk County Operating Budget; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$61,932 in Federal funds as follows:
