

**RESOLUTION NO. 58 -2014, AMENDING THE 2014 OPERATING BUDGET TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE 100% FEDERAL GRANT FUNDS PASSED THROUGH THE NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH FOR THE MATERNAL AND INFANT COMMUNITY HEALTH COLLABORATIVE INITIATIVE**

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Department of Health has awarded \$435,937 in 100% Federal grant funds to the Suffolk County Department of Health Services, Division of Patient Care Services for the Maternal and Infant Community Health Collaborative Initiative for the period 10/1/13-09/30/14; and

**WHEREAS**, this program provides funding to improve maternal and infant health outcomes for high-need women and reducing racial, ethnic and economic disparities in those outcomes through implementation of evidence-based and/or best practice strategies across the reproductive life course; and

**WHEREAS**, a portion of these funds were already included in the 2014 Adopted Operating Budget and \$23,151 needs to be appropriated; now, therefore be it

**1<sup>st</sup> RESOLVED**, that the County Comptroller and the County Treasurer be and hereby are authorized to accept and appropriate \$23,151 in grant funds as follows:
