

**RESOLUTION NO. 208-2014, AUTHORIZING USE OF  
BLYDENBURGH COUNTY PARK BY NEW YORK BLOOD  
CENTER**

**WHEREAS**, the New York Blood Center, also known as Long Island Blood Services, is one of the largest blood collection and distribution organizations in the country; and

**WHEREAS**, the New York Blood Center would like to host a fundraising hike at Blydenburgh County Park in Hauppauge to raise awareness about the need for blood donations; and

**WHEREAS**, the fundraising hike to support the New York Blood Center will be held on Saturday, May 10, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Suffolk shall receive consideration in the total amount of One Hundred and Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$150.00), payment of which shall be guaranteed by New York Blood Center.; and

**WHEREAS**, a Certificate of Insurance and accompanying declaration page naming Suffolk County as an additional insured will be provided by New York Blood Center, Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, the use of County property for a fundraising hike to support the New York Blood Center in their effort to raise awareness about the need for blood donations to the residents of Suffolk County; now, therefore be it

**1st RESOLVED**, that the use of County-owned property, Blydenburgh County Park, in Hauppauge by New York Blood Center, in consideration of the payment of One Hundred and Fifty and 00/100 Dollars (\$150.00), for the purpose of hosting a hike on Saturday, May 10, 2014, between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. is hereby approved pursuant to Section 215(1) of the NEW YORK COUNTY LAW, subject to the receipt of a Certificate of Insurance by the County of Suffolk from the Department, and subject to such additional terms and conditions as may be required by the Risk Management and Benefits Division; and be it further

**2nd RESOLVED**, that before this event shall be permitted to occur, New York Blood Center must apply for and obtain a permit from the Commissioner of the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Conservation as required by Section 643-7 of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CODE; and be it further

**3rd RESOLVED**, that the Commissioner of the County Department of Parks, Recreation and Conservation is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, pursuant to Section 28-4(A) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER, and the County Department of Public Works is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, under Section 8-2(W) of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER, to take such measures, either alone or in conjunction with each other, as shall be necessary and appropriate to facilitate the hosting of a fundraising hike to support New York Blood Center at Blydenburgh County Park in Hauppauge; and be it further

**4th**           **RESOLVED**, that New York Blood Center shall also provide an entertainment promoter certificate to Suffolk County if it wishes to allow vendors at the event to sell tangible personal property other than food or drink in order to comply with the provisions of the NEW YORK TAX LAW; and be it further

**5th**           **RESOLVED**, that this Legislature, being the lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA"), New York Environmental Conservation Law, Article 8, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action, pursuant to Volume 6 of New York Code of Rules and Regulations ("NYCRR") §617.5(c)(15), (20), and (27), in that the resolution concerns minor temporary uses of land having negligible or no permanent impact on the environment, routine, or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities, and adoption of a local legislative decision in connection with the same, and, since this is a Type II action, the County Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA.
