RESOLUTION NO. 377-2014, APPROVING THE REAPPOINTMENT OF MARIO MATTERA AS A MEMBER OF THE SUFFOLK COUNTY PLUMBING LICENSING BOARD

WHEREAS, Local Law No. 17-1971 authorized the creation of a seven member Plumbing Licensing Board; and

WHEREAS, members of the Suffolk County Plumbing Licensing Board are appointed by the County Executive, subject to legislative approval; and

WHEREAS, the term of office of Mario Mattera expired on December 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has re-nominated Mario Mattera to serve as a member of the Plumbing Licensing Board; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, that the reappointment of Mario Mattera of St. James, New York, as a member of the Suffolk County Plumbing Licensing Board, for a term of office expiring December 31, 2016, is hereby approved, said reappointment having been made pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 563 of the Suffolk County Code; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that this Legislature, being the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA) lead agency, hereby finds and determines that this resolution constitutes a Type II action pursuant to Section 617.5(c)(20), (21) and (27) of Title 6 of the NEW YORK CODE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS (6 NYCRR) and within the meaning of Section 8-0109(2) of the NEW YORK ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW as a promulgation of regulations, rules, policies, procedures, and legislative decisions in connection with continuing agency administration, management and information collection, and the Suffolk County Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) is hereby directed to circulate any appropriate SEQRA notices of determination of non-applicability or non-significance in accordance with this resolution.
