RESOLUTION NO. 397 -2014, AMEND THE 2014 OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE SUFFOLK COUNTY DEPT OF FIRE, RESCUE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (FRES)

WHEREAS, the County has authorized its Department of Fire, Rescue and Emergency Services to enter into a multi-year Agreement with the Suffolk County Vocational Education and Extension Board (“VEEB”) beginning January 1, 2014 to provide a firefighter’s training program; and

WHEREAS, the 2014 Adopted Operating Budget provides funds for VEEB to provide the firefighter’s training program for the period January through June 2014 (001-FRE-3450); and

WHEREAS, the County, in its 2014 Adopted Operating Budget, funds the firefighter’s training program for the period July through December 2014 in its Fire Training budget (001-FRE-3415); and

WHEREAS, said funds in 2014 Operating Budget should be amended to provide sufficient funding for VEEB to provide the firefighter’s training program for the 2014 fiscal year of the multi-year Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the County, in its 2014 Adopted Operating Budget, created ten (10) positions that are no longer required as a result of the above; now, therefore be it

1st **RESOLVED**, the 2014 Operating Budget is amended as follows:
