

**RESOLUTION NO. 583 -2014, APPROPRIATING FUNDS
IN CONNECTION WITH THE HISTORIC RESTORATION AND
PRESERVATION FUND (CP 7510)**

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Parks, Recreation and Conservation has requested construction funds for the stabilization, preservation and restoration of historic structures and buildings at County Parks; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds within the 2014 Capital Budget and Program to cover the cost of construction for said improvements under Capital Program Number 7510; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution 461-2006, established the use of a priority ranking system implemented in the Adopted 2014 Capital Budget as the basis for funding capital projects such as this project; and

WHEREAS, the County Legislature, by resolution of even date herewith, has authorized the issuance of \$300,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds; now, therefore be it

1st RESOLVED, pursuant to State Environmental Quality Review Act Environmental Conservation Law, Article 8, Resolution Number 485-2004 determined that the Proposed Historic Restoration, Preservation and Stabilization of Historic Buildings and Structures within Suffolk County Parks constitutes a Type II action pursuant to the provisions of Title 6 NYCRR Part 617.5 (C), (1) and (2) and Chapter 279 of the Suffolk County Code, since it involves “maintenance or repair involving no substantial changes in an existing structure or facility;” and “replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site, including upgrading buildings to meet building or fire codes, unless such action meets or exceeds any thresholds in section 617.4 of this Part;” and the Legislature has no further responsibilities under SEQRA; and be it further

2nd RESOLVED, that it is hereby determined that this project, with a priority ranking of forty (40), is eligible for approval in accordance with the provisions of Resolution No. 471-1994 as revised by Resolution 461-2006; and be it further

3rd RESOLVED, that the proceeds of \$300,000 in Suffolk County Serial Bonds be and are hereby appropriated as follows:
